ELLSWORTH Harold A. Tex Huston, 89, died Feb. 16, 2013, at an Ellsworth hospital. He was born Dec. 21, 1923, in Seal Harbor, the son of Frank A. and Agnes Huston.

Harold served in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II. He earned his BA at Gorham State Teachers College, Farmington, and his Masters in Industrial Arts at San Diego State College in California.
