Widow Margaret Stucker listed under Stucker surname with sons John, Henry, and Michael living nearby. John Miles listed as owner of land in Cork/Clark County, Kentucky, but was taxed as a resident of Woodford County, Kentucky. Margaret Stucker's son-in-law, Valentine Stoner is also listed.

Widow Margaret Stucker had sold/bequeathed 60 acres of her 400-acre grant on Glen's Creek to each of her children including Rosanna Sarah Stucker, wife of Valentine Stoner.

Margaret Stucker and John Miles, her second husband, appear to have been residing in different households, with Margaret going by the Stucker surname in 1794 (unless the Margaret listed was the daughter of widow Margaret Stucker).

No Widow Eve Stucker is listed in the 1794 tax lists, but her sons Phillip and Jacob Stucker, Jr., are listed in this tax list.
