Sister of [Anne Wormwood](#), [Jacob Wormwood](#) and [William Wormwood Jr.](#)

Wife of [Simon \(Buzzell\) Bussy](#) — married 4 Jul 1659 in Cape Porpoise, York, Maine

Mother of [Rachel \(Bussy\) Crediford](#), [John Buzzell Sr.](#), [Mary Buzzell](#), [William Buzzell](#), [Simon Buzzell](#) and [Dorcas \(Bussy\) Evans](#)

Died about 1693 at about age 55 in Boston, Suffolk, Massachusetts Bay [uncertain]

Biography

Margaret was probably born sometime before 1640 as on 4 Jul 1659 "Margerett Wormewood alias Bussy presented by the Grayne Jury for haveing a bastard, for which offence Symon Bussy & Margeret Bussie are to have 10 Lashes a peece on the bare skine, to bee given them by the appoyntment of the Commis- sioners of Falmouth & Scarborrough at a publique Meeteing. -
Witnesse Abra: Joslin"^[1] They apparently married that year.^[2]

Bradbury states that Simon and his family were taken prisoner in 1688 by the Indians and carried to Teconnet.
