are bound and firmly obliged to the Right Worshipful *WILLIAM WYNNE*, Doctor of Laws, Vicar General, and Official Principal, of the Right Reverend Father in *GOD JOHN*, by Divine Providence Lord Bishop of *Durham*, lawfully constituted, in the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds of good and lawful Money of Great-Britain, to be paid to him the said *WILLIAM WYNNE*, his Executors, Administrators, Successors, or Assigns; for the Payment whereof well and truly to be made, we oblige ourselves, and each of us by ourselves, for the Whole, and the Full, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, firmly by these Presents, Sealed with our Seals. GIVEN the *fourteenth* Day of the Month of *March* in the Year of our Lord God, One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Seventy four*.

THE Condition of this Obligation is such, that if the above bounden *John Sell* a Bachelor and *Mary Sibbil* a Spinster.

now Licensed to be Married together, be neither of Consanguinity, or Affinity, the one to the other, within the Degrees Prohibited for Marriage: If also there be no Let or Impediment, by Reason of any Precontract, entered into before the Twenty-Fifth Day of *March*, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-Four, or any other lawful Cause whatsoever but that they may be lawfully Married together, both by the Laws of *GOD*, and this Land: Moreover if the Persons whose Consent is required by Law in this behalf be thereunto agreeing: And lastly if the said Marriage be done and solemnized in such Manner as in the Licence to them granted, is limited, Then this Obligation to be void, or else to remain in full Force and Virtue.
