marriage, because he was godfather to her second son Hans Matisen, born in 1693 or 1694. We not know how things went with Ingrid's sons Jon and Hans.

We do not know for sure whether Ole and Ingrid had any children together, but they may have been the parents of Guri Olsdtr. (1708-1769), see below.

After Ole's death around 1720, the widow Ingrid kept the building on 1 field layer in the farm, while 2 field layers were built on by Erik Olsen's widow in Ustgarden. Her name was probably Kjersti (Kirsten), but may also have been called Lidsken.

Guri and Ingebrigt

In 1725, Ingebrigt Halvorsen (1698-1777) came from Halvorsgarden to Stuedal Øvre, which the widow of his uncle Erik Olsen in Ustgarden had previously had a settlement on. Ingebrigt became Olsdtr. (1708-1769), who was possibly the daughter of the above-mentioned Ole Knutsen and Ingrid Olsdtr.

From 1727, they had a new landlord to pay the building to, when the King sold Stugudalgardene to Christian Angell in Trondheim. The properties were later taken over by Thomas Angell, and after his death in 1767 they became part of Th. Angell's Foundations.

According to what we know of these children, Ingebrigt and Guri had (no. 3 is uncertain):

- 1. Half of c. 1727, probably died before 1733.
- 2. Ole (1730-1810), gm Marit Pedersdtr. Græsli (1736-1814) from Per-Hansagarden. Next users, see below.
- 3. Ingeborg (ca. 1732-1798), gm Ole Pedersen Græsli (ca. 1726-1795), brother of the abovementioned Marit. See Per-Hansagarden.
- Halvor (1733-1797), gm Seri Løvøen (1733-1826). See Løvøen, where the children are mentioned. They were users at Kirkvold for a period in the 1790s.
- 5. Maren (1737-1826), gm Lars Einarsen Løvøen (1734-1805), brother of the abovementioned Seri. They became users on Løvøen, see this.
- 6. Ingrid (1752-1828), gm Jørgen Andersen Skott (1738-1817). They became tenants at Skottgarden 92/1 in Brekken and had the children:
 - a. Anders (1785-1833), gm Ingeborg Jonsdtr. Kojan 1789. They became users of her home Kojan 132/161 in the Valset hamlet near Brekken.
 - b. Ingebrigt, gm Anne Akselsdtr. Grubben b. 1797, from Ernstgrubba Øvre 132/169 in Hitterdalen. They became users in Skottgarden.
