



Tobias Langdon in the Maine Pioneers, 1623-60

Name: Tobias Langdon

Comment: Portsmouth, had one acre of land granted him in 1658. His accounts with John Odiorne about fishing the past winter and spring, were presented in court in 1660. Made an adjustment 7 June, 1662, with Henry Sherburne, [his wife's father,] about her marriage portion, by exchange of certain lands.

Admin. of his estate was granted 27 June, 1665, to his widow Elizabeth; the eldest son was to have a double portion at 21 years of age; the other children to have single shares at 18.
