His will establishes the names of his spouse and his children as indicated below:

William Dunnivant — to loving wife Mary for life or widowhood, slaves Sara, Diso, Patt, Gilliam, and Sam, and land and plantation where I now live; — to son William Dunnivant, negro Patt, Hannah, Amey and Davy; — to son Hezekiah Dunnivant, negro Winney and Samtuler; — to son John Dunnivant, negroe Gilliam and Chloe; — to son Daniel Dunnivant, negro Sam and Finne, and one feather bed; — to son Abner, negro Sarah and Ned, and one feather bed; — to daughter Pheby Roberts, negro Judy and Dido; — to daughter Mary Dunnivant, negro Dicey and Fanny, one feather bed and horse and saddle; daughter Mary to live with executors. — to sons Daniel and Abner, land and plantation where I now live, cast lots, equally divided; — to sons Hezekiah and John, 200 acres in Prince Edward Co., to be equally divided and cast lots. — to wife Mary remainder of estate and after death or marriage to be equally divided between John, Daniel, Abner, and Mary. Executors: sons William, John and Daniel. Witnesses: Abram Dunnivant, Geo Raiburn, Norrel Dunnivant
