Be it remembered that I Catharine Widanger of the Township of Bedminster
County of Bucks and State of Pennsylvania being weak in body and of
sound mind, memory and understanding considering the uncertainty of
this transitory life, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament
in the manner and form following to wit, First - I give to my Sister
Leanna just the list of my Beds and Bedding with all that belongs
to the Bed to her heirs and assigns forever, Second - It is my will,
and I do order that my Funeral Expenses and Costs be paid from the
sole hereinafter mentioned as soon as conveniently can be after my decease,
Third - It is my will and I do order my Executor hereinafter named to
buy some stone for me, and pay the same out of my Estate, Fourth - It is my
will and I do order that all my wearing apparel be divided among all my
sisters, share and share alike to their heirs and assigns forever, Fifth - I give
to my husband David Widanger & to his one third part of the balance of my
Estate to him his heirs and assigns, Sixth - I give and bequeath the
other two thirds of my Estate to all my Brothers and Sisters share and
share alike, Seventh - I nominate and appoint my Father Peter Just
Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

In Witness whereof Catharine Widanger hereunto set my hand
and seal the twenty fourth day of May, one thousand eight hundred
and seventy. Catharine ^{the} Widanger

On the twenty fifth day of July A.D. 1870, personally
appeared before me R. K. Kuhn Deputy Register of Wills, in and for the County
of Bucks Henry Frankenthal and Abraham Stout the subscribing Witnesses
to the annexed Instruments of Writing, purporting to be the last Will and
Testament of Catharine Widanger deceased, and being first duly sworn
according to Law, did advise and say, that they were present and saw
and heard Catharine Widanger the Testatrix sign and seal, publish and
pronounce and declare, the annexed paper writing, as and for her
last Will and Testament, and that at the time of her so doing she
was of sound mind and memory, and of disposing understanding, to the
