Page 68. The accompt of Cuthbert Scott & Elisabeth, his wife, executrix of the will of John Jordain, late of SM, decd, to whom administration of the goods & chattels, right & credit of sd testator, was by the Judge for probate of wills &c, committed. The accountants charge themselves with all the goods, chattels, & debts of sd testator, specified in an inventory dated Aug 9, 1679, amounting to 61,198 lbs of tobacco. They also charge themselves with the tobacco received of Robert Carrils, being the balance of an acct with the crop of tobacco found in the house & not appraised, amounting to 5000 lbs, and a note of Arthur Thompsons, for 400 lbs, not contained in the inventory. Disbursements went to: Capt. John Quigley; Thomas Notley, Esq; Gerritt Vansweringen; Joshua Guibert; John Barnes; Robert Bridgin; Mr. Clement Hill; Mr. Nicholas Gulike; Mr. Baircroft; Mathew Cartwright; James Greenwell & Mr. William Rosewell; Capt. Sly (Slye); Richard Clillman, as by an accompt & paid by Gerrett Slye, he being the administrator of sd Clillman;
