Matthew Cartwright later of St. Mary's Co., declared in 1671 that he was "borne att Middlebourgh in the Province of Zealand under the Domion of the States Generall of the united Provinces".

CARY

Thomas Cary, of London, Merchant, imigrated to Maryland 1657.

CASH

John Cash, son of Thomas Cash, of Jamaica Place, was bound to Richard Heath for 7 years in Maryland on July 11, 1684.

CASTAGNET

Paul Castagnet, a subject of France, on Oct. 22, 1792, declared himself a Christian and subscribed to the Oath of Naturalization. County domicile not stated.

Ignatius Causine of Causine Manor, Charles Co., Md., on Apr. 7, 1671, stated that he was the "son of Nicholas Causin a Subject of the Crown of France was born at the House of his Father in St. George's River in this Province of an English Mother".
