3 Aug 1778 "general verdict" Enoch Osborn vs Abel Pennington: The land is on both sides of N fork of New River and on both sides of Horse Creek: We find the warrant should issue to said Osburn.

Abel Pennington is first known to be in Wilkes County, North Carolina in 1778. Four of his children were b. in South Carolina. When he was unable to get a deed for the property he had lived on and improved, he removed his family to Georgia. He and his sons bought and sold property and progressed across Georgia into Mississippi Territory and then on to Alabama. His will in Tuscaloosa is dated Feb 1819, with his son Abel as executor. This son is well documented in the Alabama area as late as 1838. Besides being a sheriff, he continued to run the mill his father had built.

Abel of Greenville, South Carolina

An Abel Pennington is listed in the 1790 national census of Greenville County, South Carolina. He and his wife Christian sold land in Greenville in 1803. Researchers are working a probable connection between this line and the Kentucky Abels. Abel of Clay County, Kentucky and Hendricks County, Indiana (Abel II)

This Abel was b. in South Carolina. He received many land grants on the Kentucky River, and helped organize Baptist churches in 1815 and in 1828. He d. in 1847 in Hendricks County, Indiana. (Pennington Pedigrees 4-1, 5-1, 7-2, 21-1)

Abel of Perry and Owsley County, Kentucky (Abel III)

Abel, son of Abel of Clay County, above, was b. in 1797. He m. Elizabeth Bolling, daughter of Jessie Bolling and Mary Pennington Bolling in 1815. He helped his father-in-law develop Perry County, and later became a judge. He d. in Jackson County, Kentucky in 1881. (Pennington Pedigrees 7-2,8-2, 9-1, 11-1)

I am a descendant of the Pennington and Brockett Families of England. Our John Brockett befriended Queen Elizabeth I when Mary Queen of Scots was on the throne of England. When Elizabeth took her throne back, she knighted him. They remained friends until the end.

In the fall of 1983 I published an article called the "*A Case Study of the Brockett Family in Colonial America and England*". This study began with John Brockett who sailed from England aboard the ship "Hector" arriving in Boston 26 June 1637 with the Rev. John Davenport, Theophilus Eaton and Edward Bannister. They were Puritan's. John was active in the religious settlement of New Haven with Davenport and others. The goal of the study was to determine the ancestral parentage of John Brockett in England. In the case study I wrote "little has been known concerning the life of John Brockett before his arrival in America. Yet tradition has existed for two hundred years that John Brockett was the eldest son of Sir John Brockett of Brockett Hall, Hertford, England." Descendants and genealogists for decades have generally accepted that connection. One writer wrote "On account of his Puritanical ideas, his father (who had been knighted by Queen Elizabeth) disinherited him, and that John Brockett then gave up all claims to the title and estates of the Brocketts in England, in order to join the Puritan Band which came with Rev. Davenport to America. Another tradition is that John Brockett fell in love with a Puritan maiden, that for her sake he gave up his right to the paternal estate, came to this country, established himself, provided a home for a wife, returned to England, married her and brought her to this country [America].

It makes more sense that his father would have disinherited him because he joined the Puritan Band which came with Rev. Davenport to America. His wife was Mary Blackwell. Some of this family married into the Doolittle Family.

If you are interested in any of these document, please let me know. I love to share information with others. For me, it makes more sense when we share information, which can lead to finding further information on our Ancestors.
