To which said will was annexed the following Codicell (Vizt) April the 14th 1729. This is a codicel annex to my Last Will is to shew that my desire is (unreadable word) That my Granddaughter **Elizabeth Thompson** have the white mare and my yellow gown and egroat which is mine ~

Item – to my son **Richard Willis** I give my negroe wench named **Betty** to him the said **Willis** and his heirs for ever ~

Item – I also give to the said **Elizabeth Thompson** the bed one blanket and one pair of sheets which Lies now thereon the same bed which she now lies on ~

Item – I give to my loving Grandson **Edward Newton** one negroe man called **Toby** to him and his heirs for ever ~

Item – I give to my grandson **Richard Willis** one negroe girl named **Phillis** in manner and form as the aforesaid **Robin** is given to my said grandson and his heirs for ever ~

Item – My will is like wise that the first child that the aforesaid **Phillis** is delivered of which shall live to the age of 12 months is hereby given to the proper use of **Mary Willis** sister to the aforesaid legatee **Richard Willis** to her the said **Mary** and her heirs for ever ~
