~~WILLIS DAM - This Creek was also called Willis Creek.~~

WILLIS DAM - This Creek issues westward out of the Transquaking River just south of Higgins Millpond and extends westward and then bends to the north to the vicinity of what is now Route 50 east of Mt. Holly. It was later called Haywards Dam and Haywards Branch. It derived the name Willis Dam after Richard Willis who owned land thereon. The name Hayward was derived from Francis Hayward and his family. It was also sometimes called Airey's Mill Branch. It is unnamed on present maps.

WILSON CREEK - This Creek is on the eastern side of Fishing Bay it was also called Marsh Creek and is now known as Elliott Creek.

WORLDS END CREEK - This Creek issues out of the east side of Charles Creek and is the southern border of Kerwin Neck. It derived its name from a tract called "Worlds End" which was located on its shore.

WOOLFORD CREEK - See Brooks Creek (1).

WRIGHTS CREEK - See Phillips Creek (2).

WORGANS CREEK - This Creek was what is known today as the Northern Branch of Fishing Creek.
