In the years between 1669 and 1798 the Indian population of the Choptank Indian Reservation dwindled to a mere handful. Finally, in 1798, the Maryland Assembly (Ch. 82) enacted legislation which established a commission to contract for and purchase the remaining lands of the Choptank Indian Reservation. Responsive to the 1798 legislation the following deed ensued:
