Grant *ANGLE (THE)*
No 534 To Edward Newton for 6 acres
Surveyed 3/30/1681 - Map 11

Pat. L21 F269 gives the location as: southside of Fishing Creek beginning at a marked tree, a bounded tree of the land called Paw Paw Thicket, running from thence north with the said land 75 perches to a marked oak of the said land standing by the Creekside bounding therewith south south west 48 perches. This grant was on an assignment from Thomas Pattison the assignee of Benjamin Hunt.

RR L10 F407 is noted: "Newton is dead and the land let fall."

Grant *CROWES LODGE*
No 535 To Gourney Crowe for 50 acres
Surveyed 5/16/1681 - Map 13

Pat. L CB#2 F469 gives the location as: south east side of the Blackwater River beginning at a marked oak standing on a point by a marsh from thence running north north east 50 perches to another marked oak standing by the said marsh near the riverside adjoining the land of Howell Powell from thence running east by north 187 perches.... 50 acres of this grant were on an assignment from Henry Aldred the assignee of William Merchant due the said Merchant for transporting Mary Saunders.

RR L10 F409 notes: "No heir to be found."
