SUSANNA GERARD SLYE is the daughter of DR. THOMAS GERARD and wife, SUSANNA SNOW. She married ROBERT SLYE in St. Mary's County, Maryland. After the death of ROBERT SLYE, SUSANNA married COL. JOHN COODE. Susanna was still living in December of 1681 as recorded in the "Chronicles of St. Mary's County".

When ROBERT SLYE married SUSANNA GERARD, her father, THOMAS GERARD conveyed to his son-in-law and his eldest daughter, a tract of land containing approximately 6,000 acres, which was a part of "Saint Clements Manor" on January 26, 1654. He had already given them about 1,000 acres, which was known by the name of "White Point". This tract of land had been a wedding dower to his daughter upon her marriage to ROBERT SLYE. SLYE renamed this manor "Bushwood". There he established his residence, raised his family and devoted his remaining sixteen years to the acquisition of additional property and making improvements to his Estate.

CHILDREN OF ROBERT AND SUSANNA GERARD SLYE ARE:

(1) Frances Slye was born ca 1669 in St. Mary's County, Maryland; died there; Her Last Will & Testament was dated March 14, 1698. She married first, Ignatius Wheeler, son of John Wheeler and wife, Mary, and second Peter Miles. In the Last Will & Testament of her father, Robert Slye, she receives a part of "Rich Neck" (500 acres), aka "Maiden's Bower".

(2) Capt. Gerard Slye was born in St. Mary's County, Maryland; died 1733 there according to book: "Maryland Calendar of Wills". Working with his father in the extensive mercantile business, he maintained dual residence, living at both "Bushwood" and in London. Later, Capt. Slye inherited "Bushwood" from his father, Robert Slye. Capt. Slye's Last Will & Testament was probated in 1733. He most likely was buried in the family graveyard.

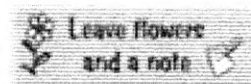

Gardiner, who died in 1705. She married second Edward Cole on 7 October 1714 and he died in 1717 without issue. Upon her father's death, Elizabeth received a part of "Rich Neck" (500 acres).

She is established in The National Society, Colonial Dames XVII Century.
