Inventory, £144, 15s., purse and wearing apparel £17, 19s., gun, sword, books £1, pair of oxen, 2 cows, 2 yearlings, 2 calves, a mare, colt, 30 sheep, 7 lambs, 8 swine.

1750, Sep. 17. Will—proved 1757, Jul. 30. Widow Mary. Ex. cousin John Tarbox. To grandson John Straight, residing in Coventry, leather bed, pewter, 50. To cousin Thomas Shippey, iron pot. To cousin Sarah Bentley, pewter basin. To cousin Anne Spink, pewter basin. To sister Shippey, clothes box. Executor to sell my cow and I pay my grandson John Straight's seven children, 10s. apiece, viz. to Thomas, Phoebe, William, Hannah, Henry, John and Job. To cousin John Tarbox, rest of estate.
