Parents: inspector in Nordland and Finnmark, later bookseller and teacher Didrik Brinch. (1631-86) and Helena (Lene) His daughter (died earlier in 1692).

Married 1st time 07/20/1692 in London with Ambrosia Michelsen, probably baptized 11. 18.1670 in Christiania, died 08.01.1709 in Copenhagen (Holmen), on the citizen in Christiania Henrik M. (died 1687) and Catherine Torchelus (death no earlier than 1702).

Married 2nd time 09/03/1710 in Copenhagen (Holmen) with Sophie Seidelinsgade, born 1693, died 13.8.1741 (married 2nd time in 1735 by Bishop Christian Ramus, 1687 (8) -1762), on the later Postmaster-General, Councillor Hans S. (1665-1740) and Drude Margrethe Clausdatter (d. 1711).
