And Mary Brown of the Parish of Hamsted-Noris in the County Aforesaid Widow - Having & Declared their Intentions of Marriage Before severall Monthly & Meetings Both of men and women of the People of God Called Quakers According to the good order used Amongst them where it was Inquired into and seriously and Deliberately Considered of and Sufficient Evidence being Produced of Relations and Friends Consent and of their Clearness From all others it was Approved of by the said Meetings as by the Records Belonging to them it doth more at large Appear (Now these present witnesseth that For the Full Determining of the Intentions Aforesaid. upon the twenty fifth day of Aprill In the year According to the Account now used in England one Thousand Six hundred ninety and fouer. In A publique Assembly at ore in The County Aforesaid Did solemnly take each other as husband and wife Promising to be faithfull one to the other as husband and wife so long as they should live and these whose names are here & Under written were witnesses of the same the day and year above written -
