Ship Description: Built by Palmer's Shipbuilding & Iron Co., Newcastle, England. Tonnage: 3,238. Dimensions: 366' x 43'. Single-screw, 11 1/2 knots. Compound engines. Two masts and one funnel. Iron hull.

History: Maiden voyage: Liverpool-New York, November 25, 1870. At later date tonnage increased to 3,700. Scrapped in 1893. Sister ship: Wisconsin. Note: The earliest compound-engined steamships built for trans-Atlantic service.

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
