Schofield Kershaw. Wife and Two Daughters Run Down by Train at Layton.

ALL FOUR INSTANTLY KILLED.

Parties Were Driving Home From Lagoon When Los Angeles Limited Duslied Into Them.

An accident that shed sorrow and gloom in nearly every Davis county home was that which caused the death last evening of Schoffeld Kershaw, wife and two daughters. The buggy in which they were riding was struck by a south-bound C. S. Litcain at Layton, the four were killed and the budies terribly mutilitied.

Mr. and Mrs. Kershiw had spent the day at Lagoon, where they had assisted to entertain the eigl folks. They took the 7 occlock train of the Salt Lake & orden railway for home, and were mer at the Larton reation by their two danghters. Rhody and Ahna, aged 15 and 13 years respectively. The vehicle was a single, top-buggy and after making a tist at the store of Adoms & Sans, the parents and children proceeded to drive to their home. The girls were sitting on their father and mother's laps and thooks was driving. The train that struck tise unfortunates was traveling at a high rate of speed so fast that it was a matter of talk smoon some of the cassengers before Lavton was reached.

A subject prevented the occupants of the buggy from socing the impending danger, and the schole was bit squaredly, the horse having chared the track. In some trainceleable way the body of each of the victims remained from or under the engine until a stop to made, marry a mile from the secret of the accident. Immediately behind the concurction were found the remains of the father and reumnest daughter, close together and terribly mangled. The mother and color child some estangled in one of the axely, but were fast so much applicable. Death for all must have been instantions.

Presergers assisted the control in taking the badies from the envine. Persons who had witnessed the accident a tille away also hastened to the scate. Strong men paid and became whit from the static, and when the word sprend of the misfortune there was monifest sorrow on every hand. The news was carried to Lagren and these who were yet on the grounds were much depressed at so terrible an ending

age, and his wife a trito younger.
Seven children carvive them, two of
whom are married, namely, Samuel M.
and Mrs. Jennic Brown, the former a
resident of Ogden and the latter living
at West Layton, The other children
are Ada, Sarah, Daniel, Cyrus and
Produce The last named is 10 years
old, and wanted to go to meet his parents, but for lack of room his request
was decided.

The Kershau family is highly respected by all who are acquainted with the respective numbers, and the community decidy feels the loss of the four unfortunates. The remains are at the undertaking establishment of John Barton, and funeral arrangement are being made.
