The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A black and white photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photograph must be on this form, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

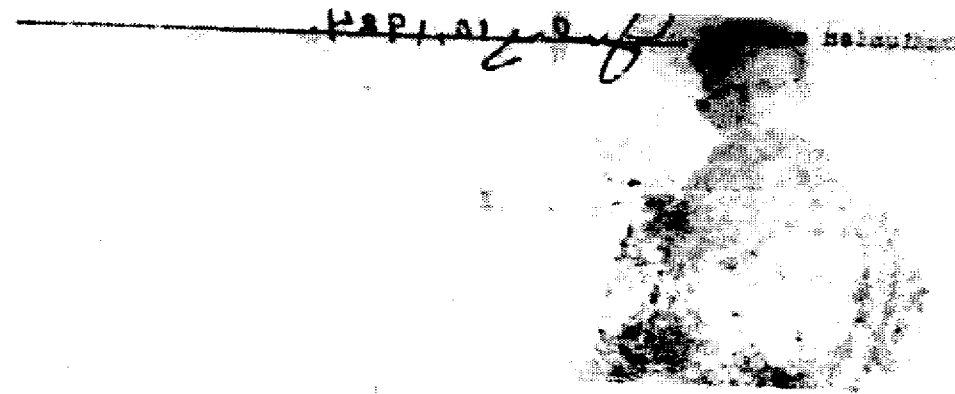
