

In the Name of God Amen I Mary Gilbert of Paulton in the Parish of Monks Kirby in the County of Warwick Widow being of perfect disposing Mind Memory and Understanding (God be there for praised) do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (viz) first and principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of God who gave it and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named and as touching my worldly Estate I dispose thereof as followeth I give unto my son Edward Gilbert one Shilling Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Brown three Pounds and all my wearing apparel both Linens and Woollens except my best Mantua Item I give unto my daughter Jane Stans one Shilling Item I give unto my daughter Anne Gilbert five Pounds all which Legacies shall be paid within one year next after my decease Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Gilbert my joynt Bedstead with the Bed and bedding upon it and all furniture therunto belonging standing in the Chamber over the Houe also my best Chest and Trunk and all other my Goods and moveables, Monneys and Personal Estate whatsoever, and I do hereby make and ordain my said daughter Elizabeth Gilbert Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament. Charging her with the payment of all my Debts Legacies and funeral expences and lastly I do hereby revoke and annul all other Wills made by me here before Databifing this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the twenty third day of September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred thirty and one
