In the name of god Amen the third day of may in the thirtenth year of the reign of our Sovereign
 Lord Charles by the grace of god King of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender of the
 faith of Italy died 1637. of Thomas Parkinson of Hpton in the County of Lancashire being sick
 and weak in body but of sound and perfect mynd and memory praised be god for the same I do
 make publish and declare this my last will and testament in manner and forme followinge that
 it to say first and principally I commit my soule into the hands of Almighty god trustinge
 to be saved only by the death and passion of Jesus Christ and my body to Christian buriall
 when and where it shall please god, and concerninge the disposicion of my temporall goodes
 it as my will and mynd that they be divided into three equal parts, the first part wherof I
 give unto Jane my wyffe, the second part wherof I give unto Abbe my daughter
 the third and last part I bequeath to my sonne to be part as followeth that is to say I give and
 bequeath unto William Parkinson my sonne ten pound sterlinge and I give unto the said William
Parkinson a plough and two harrowes, the great arke in the barn, in one yoke and a team and
 a murrer. Moreover I give unto my Exors^{es} hereafter named the summe of ten pound sterlinge
 for the use and benefite of all the children of Thomas Charles my sonne law and to be employed
 for their best benefite accordinge to the direction of my said Exors^{es}, Item I give unto
 the said Thomas Charles and Margarett his wyffe twentie shillinges a peece, Item I
 give unto Richard Morritt and Richard Morritt his brother ten shillinges a peece, Item I
 give unto my servant Margery Maske land ten shillinges, Item I give unto my servant
Thomas preacher of gods word at Deane ten shillinges, Item I give unto Thomas
Lough and of my Exors^{es} ten shillinges, all the rest of my goodes after my debts legacis
 and funeral expens discharged I give and bequeath unto Jane my said wyffe and Abbe
 my said daughter equally betwixt them, and of this my said last will and testament
 I ordeyne and make my Exors^{es} William Parkinson my said sonne Thomas Lough of
Humme and Richard Morritt of Hpton to execute as seeme as my trust is in them
 as is expressed in verball wherof of the said Thomas Parkinson have hereto put my hand &
 sealed the day and yeare first above written.
