When Margaret Drake was born in 1663, in Chorlton by Backford, Cheshire, England, her father, John Drake, was 29 and her mother, Dorothy Cottrell, was 28. She married Thomas Baxter III in 1684, in Backford, Cheshire, England. They were the parents of at least 6 sons and 5 daughters. She lived in Marton, Cheshire, England in 1663. She died in 1712, in Backford, Cheshire, England, at the age of 49, and was buried
