The Condition of this p[ro]curator obligam is such that if hereafter there shall
 not arise nor be found any lawful lett or impediment by reason of
 any strait or Contingency, or Affinity, but of George Roe of the
 parish of Graynor & Elizabeth Calladine — they lawfully solemnize
 Matrimony together & afterwards in the same lawfully remain like
 man & wife according to the laws in this Kingdom & give obedience
 if there be not at this p[ro]curator any other due unto God or man
 made yet either of the said p[ro]curator for any such matter or Cause before any
 Judge Ecclesiastical or Temporal And also if the said p[ro]curator do not consent
 to the solemnization of their said Matrimony will not be bound of the
 Parents or other kindred nor at any other place in the fear of the
 Church of England — Nor at any other time
 in London the value of a pair of the Cloths with the Appurtenances there
 this Bond well void of none effect or discharge in full force power
 or value
