### THE FAMILY OF BENJAMIN<sup>3</sup> PERRY OF SOUTH KINGSTOWN

Edward<sup>1</sup> PERRY was of Sandwich, Mass in 1653. He had three  
 sons Samuel, Benjamin, and Edward. Two of these sons Samuel<sup>2</sup>  
 and Benjamin<sup>2</sup> and a grandson Edward<sup>3</sup> (Edward<sup>2</sup>) settled in Rhode  
 Island and established three Perry lines there. Benjamin<sup>2</sup> Perry was  
 the ancestor of Commodores Oliver Hazard Perry and Matthew Perry  
 concerning whom considerable has been written. Samuel<sup>2</sup> and Ed-  
 ward<sup>3</sup> Perry also had numerous descendants some of whom still live  
 in Washington County, R.I. Austin in his Genealogical Dictionary  
 covered only the descendants of Samuel<sup>2</sup>, and in the original ed-  
 ition gave none of the children of Benjamin<sup>3</sup> who were listed by
