Worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when ever it shall please God to call me home do therefore make and publish this as for and my last will and Testament in manner and form following Viz. First of all I order and Direct my Executors to pay all my Just Debts and funeral charges before any Distribution of my Estate takes place — Secondly I give and Devise unto my Daughter Susannah Raymer and to her heirs and Assigns forever, all that Tract or Parcel of Land and Premises on which I now live called Philips Delight which was Granted to me for Six and a half Acres by Patent bearing Date the Twenty eighth day of June Seventeen hundred and Eighty five —

Thirdly I give and Devise unto my housekeeper Catherine Speelman to her and her heirs and Assigns forever all that part of a Tract of Land and Premises being that part of a Tract of Land called "The Resurvey on Coopers Alley" which was conveyed to me by Peter Stone for Seven Acres of Land by Deed bearing date the twenty second day of September Seventeen hundred and ninety seven I also give and bequeath unto her the said Catherine Speelman and her heirs One Milks Cow, one large Iron Pot, and one Dutch Oven, one Iron Ladle, and flesh fork, also one Barrel and one half Barrel, one Che, and one Pot Rack, one Poplar Table and two Chairs, one Cow Chain and two hogs Ten Bushels of Corn and ten Bushels of Rye —

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Senrager five shillings current money which is to be in full of her portion of my Estate — Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my son a carb Goodman four Dollars current money which is to be in full of his portion of my Estate — Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my son George Goodman two Dollars current money, which is to be full of his portion of my Estate —

Seventhly I hereby Order and direct that my Executors shall at the Expiration of Three years after my Decease sell and Convey all my Real Estate of which I may Die Possessed and seized in fee, be the same more or less, except all such Lands as are herein before already Deviced, And it is my will and desire that they shall sell the same to the best Advantage at public Sale they first giving full and sufficient Notice of such Sale by Advertisement of the time and place thereof And the money arising from the Sale thereof to be Equally Divided Between my Sons Philip Goodman William Goodman David Goodman and my Daughters Susannah Raymer Mary Fuller, Catharine Goodman and Rachel Goodman and my Grand son Christian Shoup Share and Share a like —

Frederick County to wit on the 23rd day of November 1807 then came Philip Goodman & William Goodman and made Oath on the holy Evangel of Almighty God that the foregoing Instrument of writing is the True whole will and Testament of William Goodman late of Frederick County Deceased that hath come to their hands and possession and that they do not know of any other

It is further my will and Desire and I do here by order and direct that my said Executors shall immediately after my Death Rent out all my lands three years (except those Devised to my Daughter Susannah Raymer and Catherine Speelman) to the best advantage and to pay all my Just Debts out of the first Rents that are paid in and the remainder (if any) to be Equally divided between the Eight Legatees last above named share and share alike —

And Whereas I have heretofore given my Daughter Susannah Raymer a Deed of Gift for my Lands, which she had promised to reconvey to me when ever I should require or Demand it — It is therefore my will and Desire that she, Together with her husband Peter Raymer do immediately after my Decease reconvey unto my Executors all such lands conveyed by the said Deed of Gift, for the benefit of all the Legatees here in before mentioned which may be entitled to the same —

I do hereby further direct that my Executors shall leave Catherine Speelman live one year after my Decease on the place on which I now live quietly and peaceably without any Interruption or molestation by any person whatever, and do hereby direct her the said Catherine Speelman, after the Expiration of one year after my Decease to give peaceable possession of the said Land and premises unto my son in law Peter Raymer, to whose wife the same is Devised — And in Addition to what I have already bequeathed unto the said Catherine Speelman I give and bequeath unto her heirs two flour Barrels and one tubb and one Wedding hoe —

Further Give and Bequeath unto my son William Goodman my feather bed, Bedstead & Bed Steaks he also one Chest to him & his heirs and Assigns —

And Lastly I constitute and appoint my sons Philip Goodman and William Goodman Executors of this my last will and Testament Revoking and making Void all former wills or Bequests by me at any time heretofore made or executed ratifying and confirming this and ~~no other~~ to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have heretofore set

my hand and Affixed my seal this ^{25th} day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & Seven
