

I Christina Noll (widow) of the Township of Londonderry, in the County of Dauphin and State of Penn<sup>a</sup> do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner, as follows: First I direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian-like manner at the discretion of my Executors, and as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to entrust me with I give and devise the same as follows, I direct that my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently can be done by my Executors out of the first money that comes to their hands from any portion of my estate, and what shall be left from my estate real & personal after the payment of my debts I order and direct that the same shall be equally divided among my five children now living, viz: Henry, John, Christian, David and Elizabeth intermarried with John Grubb. And further I do hereby constitute and appoint my son John Noll and my son-in-law John Grubb Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made, and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
