Ohio, settling mainly in Lawrence Co, Jackson Co, and Gallia Co.


Hans George Noll came in the ship Loyal Judith of London from Rotterdam, Last from Cowes, England.

Philadelphia on September 25, 1732. He settled in Berks County Pennsylvania. On board ship there were 119 men.

The first Noll of our family was John George Noll. He traveled down

the Rhine River from his home in Alsaac-Lorraine, Germany to Rotterdam, Holland where he boarded The Ship Loyal Judith with Robert Turpin as the Master. Theship sailed from Rotterdam, then stopped at Cowes, England before arriving in Philadelphia, Pa., on

September 25, 1732.

John George Noll was listed as 36 years of age on the ship's list of passengers. He was born in 1696 and died in 1753 in Rockingham

county, virginia. Due to the translations of German to English also many of the people could not read or write the other's language, there

is numerous spelling of his name. On one ships list he is Hans George

Noll. On another it is John Jurig Noll and also found in other records

as Hans Jerig Noll. However they all mean John George Noll. Also

this ship there was a Jacob Buhlmayer (Billmyer). Further on in this

history we will run across this name, as the wife of a descendant of

John George Noll. He was probably an ancestor of hers.

John George's wife was named Anna Margaretha and she was born

in Germany also.

John George Noll and Anna Margaretha's children: Balser, John, Nichalos, Anna Cathrina, Anna Maria, and maybe another son.
