I also Give and bequeath unto my son James Peokes five shillings

I also Give and bequeath unto my son Bengeman Peokes one negro man Named Toby and his wife Jeney to him his heires or asines for Ever

I also Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Naemy Edmond one Negro Girl named Nancy to her her heires and Asines for Ever

I also Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Marey Warinton one Negro Girl named Bes to her her hers and Asines for Ever.

I also Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rachell Prichard one Neare Boy named Dick to her her Heirs and Asins for Ever

I Give and bequeath unto my son Danell Peokes and my five daughters Elizabeth Cripin Sarah Idlet Marey Warinton Naemy Edmond Rachel Prichard all my movable Hewes all Goods and all English Goods that I have to be Equally sheared between Danell Peokes and his five sisters with Indien Ceara and Tobaccow allse to be devidid between ye: six. I also Apoint my son Bengeman Peokes and Danell Peokes to be my Exeekters Jontly together to see this my will performed according to the true meaning and sence Hereof
