Page 121-~~TATOM, JOHN, Sr.~~ Wife Sarah to use all estate for her subsistence during life. Son William, to have a cow, etc., in proportion with other children.
The estate to be divided into nine equal parts, ~~one to the children of my dec'd dau. Henrietta Fullilove~~, one to the children fo my dau. Elizabeth Ann Hicks, one to the children of dec'd. dau. Keziah, five pounds of said share to Samuel Goodwin, her eldest son, the remainder in three parts, one to the other son, and the other third to her daughters (not named). ~~The other six parts to be divided equally among the rest of my children, not named, my son in this state to give notice to those in N. C., before a division.~~
Sons Abel, Abner John and William,
Excrs. Signed Mar. 21, 1793. Probated Oct. 8, 1794. Thomas Owens, James Hester, Thomas Shannon, Test.
