

3. Joseph BUNKER, born about 1702 Dover, NH. Married (1) before 1721, Ann GILES, born 1 October 1702, daughter of Mark GILES and Sarah, and sister of Sarah GILES

who married his brother James BUNKER. He married (2) Elizabeth (--?--), who was living in 1778. He died July 1784, buried 18 July 1784. His will, dated 9 September 1778 and probated 11 August 1784, referring to him as "*of Durham, yeoman, being very aged*" names wife Elizabeth, son Benjamin who was named Executor and to whom the homestead "where I now live" and grist mill were left, son James to whom was given "*lands in Durham granted to me as one of the proprietors of said common land in Durham,*" son Jonathan BUNKER, daughter Ann, the wife of Joseph STEVENSON, and daughter Patience, the widow of John CLEMENTS. Children:

a. Patience BUNKER, born about January 1721 Dover, NH; died about 1 July 1822 age 101 years 6 months Milton, NH. (Boston Independent Chronicle and Patriot, issue 1 July 1822). Married (1) after 1753 as his 2nd wife, John TWOMBLY JR. born 28 October 1712, died between 5 May - 29 August 1764, son of John TWOMBLY and Sarah DAME. Married (2) about 1768 John CLEMENTS, born about 1735 Dover, NH, died 8 May 1776 Dover, NH, son John CLEMENTS and Sarah BUNKER.
