Sarah Ellen Richards Cannon passed away March 27, 1988 at age 98 at her daughter's home. Born July 13, 1889 in Tooele, she was the daughter of President George F. Richards and Alice Robinson Richards.

She married Hugh J. Cannon in the Salt Lake LDS Temple July 26, 1917. He died Oct 6, 1931.

She was active in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, having served as a worker in the Salt Lake Temple and for over 25 years as a member of the YWMIA General Board.

With her husband as mission president, she filled a three-year mission in the Swiss-German Mission.

She is survived by three sons and one daughter: George Richards (Lois) Cannon, St. George; Alice Richards Cannon (Lloyd R.) Hicken, Bountiful; Max Richards (Elsie) Cannon, Tucson, Ariz; and Dean Richards (Pauline) Cannon, Bountiful.

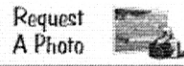
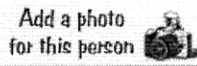

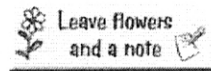
