P 40 Know all men by these presents that we **Toliver B Goolsby, Allen Goolsby, Jonathan Rains** and **William Cunningham** are held and firmly bound unto their Honors the Justices of the Inferior Court, sitting for Ordinary purposes for said county, and their successors in office in the just and full sum of five thousand dollars, for the payment of which sum to the said justices and their successors in office, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this third day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty two. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Toliver Goolsby is this day appointed guardian to **Andy** and **Paschal** orphans of **Andy Pye** deceased. Now if the said Toliver B Goolsby do well and truly demean himself as guardian -----

P 41 Know all men by these presents that we **John Gilmer** and **William H Smith** are held and firmly bound unto their Honors the Judges of the Inferior Court, sitting for ordinary purposes for said county and their successors in office in the just and full sum of three thousand dollars, for the payment of which sum to the said judges and their successors in office, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 2nd day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty two. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said John Gilmer is this day appointed guardian to **Joel B Gresham** orphan of **John Gresham** deceased. Now if the said John Gilmer do well and truly demean himself as guardian -----

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound John Floyd administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of **David Busbin** late of this county deceased do make a true and perfect inventory.-----

P 44 Know all men by these presents that we **Artimas W Oglivie, William Oglivie, Burrell Pope** and **Henry Jordan** are held and firmly bound unto their Honors the Justices of the Inferior Court for said county sitting for Ordinary purposes and their successors in office in the just and full sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the payment of which sum to the said justices and their successors in office, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators in the whole and for the whole sum, jointly and

June 1798 Term

Alexander Moss vs Nathaniel Moss and Samuel Moss. We the jury find for the defendant. **James Stovall, Foreman**

Alexander Moss vs Nathaniel Moss. The plaintiff being three times called and failing to appear, it is ordered a nonsuit.

Thomas W Grimes vs George Lumpkin. One of the jury not answering to their name it is ordered a miss trial.

William Thompson vs Jeffery Earley. We the jury find for the plaintiff fifty three dollars fifty eight cents with interest and cost. **James Stovall, Foreman**

Richard Rutherford came into court and was qualified as Constable for Cspt Robert's District.

Isham Sharp vs George Lumpkin We the jury do find for the plaintiff five hundred and thirty dollars seventy nine cents provided he has receipts produced in ten months for three hundred fifty dollars. We having made that deduction if not produced within ten months, then three hundred and fifty dollars to be added. **John Holmes, Foreman**

Whereas it appears that **James Sanders Sr** at the last Inferior Court was appointed a guardian to the orphans of **John Johnson** deceased and it appearing to this court that the said Sanders has had no property of the said estate, he is therefore upon his application discharged from his said guardianship.

Jacob McElroy came into court and was qualified as Constable for Capt Hudspeth's District. agreeable to law. **Jeremiah Wooten** continued for Wagon's District, **William Jones** is appointed Constable for Capt Mathews District and **Walter Maxey** continued for Capt Stewart's District. **Frederick Varner** continued in Capt McElroy's District.

Ordered that **Samuel Beavers**, son of **John Beavers** deceased, eight years old be bound to **James Armstrong** until he arrives to the age of twenty one years.

On application it is ordered that **Malcom Curray** be exempt from paying pole tax

Ordered that **Abel Howard, Thomas Riddle, Joel Barnett, Henry Taylor** and **Nicholas Gilmore** be appointed commissioners to view and report to the next court the convenience of a ford on the south fork of Broad River known by the name of Poge's Shoals and whether the logs that is thrown into the river is any obstruction to the ford.

Samuel Patton came into court and was qualified as Constable for Capt Brooker's District agreeable to law.

John B Parks vs Isham Smith and William Bledsoe. Isaac Collier do acknowledge myself bound with the defendant in the above case, it being for the stay of execution sixty days. June 24th , 1802.

Jesse Posey by his friend **Bethlain Posey vs Daniel Jackson** Appeal. In this case the defendant being dissatisfied with the judgement of the jury appeals to the Superior Court and gives **Isaac Collier** for his security 24th June 1804.

Executors of **Aquilla Greer** deceased vs **Isaac Dotson and John Stewart** stay of execution. I, **William Stewart** do acknowledge myself bound with the defendant in the above case, it being for the stay of execution sixty days June 25th 1802

Executors of **Aquilla Greer** deceased vs **Yelverton Maxey and William Stewart** stay of execution. I, **Walter Maxey** do acknowledge myself bound with the defendant in the above case, it being for the stay of execution sixty days. 25th day of June 1802.

Executors of **Harrison Musgrove** deceased vs **Alexander Gordon.** I confess judgement for fifty dollars with interest and cost.

Administrators of **B Blake** deceased vs **Joseph Wilson, Joseph Wise and George Barber.** We the jury find for the plaintiff fifty six dollars with interest and cost. **James Broughton,** Foreman

⑥ **Thomas Duke** for the use of **James Armstrong vs William Payton and Thomas Brooks.** I confess judgement to the plaintiff for the sum of two hundred and forty one and eighty five cents.

John B Parks vs Stephen Flint and William Freeman. We find for the plaintiff sixty seven dollars and half cent with cost. **Reuben Booth,** Foreman

Stephen Flint vs Pechy Bledsoe We find for the plaintiff two dollars and twenty four cents with cost. **James Broughton,** Foreman

Benjamin Baldwin vs Fleming Jordan and John Grimes and Lawrence Briers. Death of the defendant John Grimes suggested. We the jury who return the following, we find for the plaintiff fifty two dollars and fifty cents with interest and cost against Lawrence Briers. **William George ,** Foreman.

Benajmin Borough vs Richard Dent and Reuben Booth action for debt. We the jury find for the plaintiff one hundred and seven dollars forty nine cents with interest and cost. **William George,** Foreman.
