

This Indenture made this 11th day of March 1831 between
 Stewart widow of Allen Stewart, George Logan late husband of
 Stewart, or Sarah Stewart, his wife, George Calton, late husband of
 Stewart all heirs representatives of Allen Stewart, dec^d of the first part
 William Stone of the county of Henry & State of Ky of the second part, they
 that for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars per acre five hundred
 Dollars of which, in hand paid, and the balance to be paid, in twelve months,
 they the parties of the first part, have and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell convey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part all their in-
 terests, interests, in a certain tract of land, in Henry County Ky on the
 waters of Shell creek part of John Hays 3000. acre survey, and divided to
 Stewart dec^d by deed of Record, in the Henry County Clerk's office, (the said
 Francis Stewart, meaning to convey her dower interest, in said land, being
 41 acres, & 76 poles, and each of the aforesaid items being entitled to an equal
 interest in said dower at the death of the said, Francis Stewart) mean to
 convey said interest

 allotted to John Logan containing 24 acres, George Calton being entitled, to
 lot B^o containing 22 1/2 acres, John Stewart being entitled, to lot C^o contain-
 24 acres, as by appraisement, to a division made amongst, the heirs of Allen
 Stewart, dec^d of the 15th of Nov. 1821 of record, in the Henry County Clerk's
 office, will more fully appear, mean to convey said lots, together with all
 and singular, the premises, hereby conveyed and appurtenances, to have
 and to hold, said land, hereby conveyed, and appurtenances, with laws that
 said William Stone, his heirs or assigns forever, and the said parties, of
 the first part severally for them selves, or assigns, their respective interests,
 and lots of said land freed from the claims of themselves, their heirs or assigns
 and from the claim, of all and every person, whatsoever, claiming, or to claim
 the same, well warrant and forever defend by these presents.

But it is distinctly understood covenanted & agreed, between the
 parties, that they the heirs &c of Allen Stewart dec^d are only severally
 bound, for the interest, and land they each convey and should it be lost
 by a poor or better title that they are bound only to refund. The purchase
 money but without interest, each one being bound only for what he or she
