to John Tool & Elizabeth Williams, & one sixth part to Joseph

Cather's son George the negro woman called Rechel provided he
pay the sum of Twenty pounds, that is to say to my son John
one sixth part to my son Andrew one sixth part to my son
George one sixth part, and one sixth part to John Tool & Elizabeth
Williams & the other sixth part to Thomas Cather Bramley and
Andrew Anderson Wallace & the other sixth part to Joseph &
Hugh M'Goon, and all the rest of my worldly goods to be equal
ly divided in six shares between my son John one sixth &
my son Andrew one sixth & my son George one sixth part & one
sixth part to John Tool & Elizabeth Williams, one sixth to Thomas

- I give demise bequeath & dispose of the same in the following manner & from my part of all that all those debt & debts that I owe to any person or persons be first & satisfied or contrived to be paid in convenient time by my Executors here after named -
- Item I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary my dwelling house excepting Pollys Room her bed & then full furniture thereto belonging & the kitchen & what thereon is including pots & all vessels of Looking a boy mare her saddle & bridle three cows her own choosing five head of sheep & what the crosses of Hogs, her living during life in said house & off said plantation in a peaceable quiet manner a negro woman named Pender to be at her own disposal to her & her heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Jane a negro woman named Phillis to her & her heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth a negro woman Coge to her & her heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary a tract of land containing 320 acres known by the name of Sellers land & a negro woman named Juno to her & her heirs & assigns forever I also give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary her Room in my dwelling house to be occupied & used by her during her widowhood -
- Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor a negro woman named Fern now in her possession to her & her heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I give & bequeath to my Grandson (my son's son) five negroes named Dantes & Sue to them their heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I give & bequeath to my son Archibald the plantation whereon I now live 700 acres my Wagon & all the Horses that is now herein bequeath, plow & tools & what belongs to belonging all plantation implements with the remainder of Stock of every kind my Mill & Millstone five negroes viz. Tom, Will, Pinner & Peter with the residue of household furniture to him his heirs & assigns forever -
- Item I name, nominate, constitute & appoint my loving wife Mary & my son Archibald Executors of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking & disannulling all former & other Wills bequests, Demises and Executions by me in any

with name bequeatheth or Demised hereof, Notifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament.

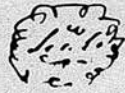
