





# **Biography**

Joseph held land on Lane's Creek and Brown Creek in Anson Co until 1777 when he and Joel MCLENDON moved into SC. Joseph was a probably a Patriot in SC as Joseph HUFF during the Rev. War, then was in Washington Co, GA, in 1794. Joel MCLENDON also moved to Washington Co, GA, where he was quite active in the militia. Joseph in 1794 bought two tracts of land in Chesterfield Co, SC, recorded in 1796. Where he went after that is uncertain but like lived out his life in Chesterfield District.

Two early Anson County land grants (#0323 Lane's Ck. on 25 Sep 1766 and #2507 Brown Ck. on 22 Dec 1768) were obtained by Joseph HOUGH in Anson county. Lanes creek was for Junior and the latter grant on Brown Creek for Senior.

SC historian, professor and author, Louise Pettus referenced  ${}^{\hbox{\scriptsize [1]}}$  a new regulation showing that in 1763, it was directed that no person hereafter applying for warrants of survey should be allowed land for children above the age of 15. Thus, our subject must have been born no later than 1749 to receive his property. In 1766 these NC grants were required to be signed over (through a Memorial) to the "New State of SC" in order to maintain legal title.
