

Mrs. Rosannah Reynolds, 90 years of age, died of general debility at the residence of her daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Langston, 769 Second East street, at 5:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon.

Mrs. Reynolds was a native of England, having been born in Lancashire, Nov. 30, 1823. She came to Utah with her parents, Joseph and Elizabeth Kings Hunting, in September, 1868.

Mrs. Reynolds is survived by five children: Mrs. Elizabeth Langston, Mrs. Ann Rigby and William H. Smith of this city, and Mrs. Amelia Wilson and Thomas Smith of Wanship. The funeral will be held Sunday at 2 o'clock p.m. at the Third ward meetinghouse.

This is actually Hannah Hunting Smith Reynold

Because her 2nd husband, Henry Reynolds, had wives, both named Hannah, he called this Hannah "Ros Hannah," which has been spelled also as Roseannah, Roseanna and Rosannah.

Other errors in this obituary:

- 1. Hannah Hunting was born in Dormston, Wordesters not in Lancashire, England.*
- 2. Her parents were named James (not Joseph) and Elizabeth Kings Hungting.*
- 3. She immigrated to the U.S. in 1868 with her husband William Smith, and their children. Her parents came Utah in 1853.*
