Note C.—Questions Nos. 13, 14, 22 and 23 are not to be asked in respect to persons under 10 years of age.

Note B.—In making entries in columns 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 to 23, an affixation to mark only will be used—thus /, except in the case of colored persons, when T, when the letter "D" is to be used.  
Note C.—Question 14 will only be asked in cases where an affirmative answer has been given either to question 13 or to question 15.  
Note D.—Question 16 will only be asked in cases where a qualified occupation has been reported in column 13.  
Note E.—In column 1 an abbreviation in the name of the month may be used, as Feb., Apr., Dec.
