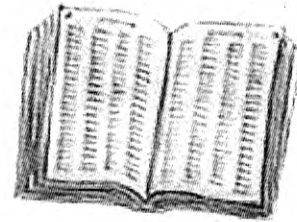

ABOUT KANSAS, WORLD WAR I BOUNTY CLAIMS INDEX

This database is from the [Kansas Historical Society](#), and originally entitled World War I Bounty Claims. The descriptive information here is adapted from the Kansas Historical Society website. More information about the database may be available there.

These records contain copies of enlistment and discharge papers for members who applied for a state bonus for service in World War I. The applicant could be the veteran, or their widows/orphans. Each entry includes the following, when available: name, service #, claim #, rank, military branch, papers, and any notes.

There are records for those who served in the military for a short time and for their entire career, those who died while on active duty, and those who received military benefits after their retirement. Not only can military records provide information about an individual ancestor, they can also provide information about an ancestor's family. Spouses, children, parents, and siblings from Kansas may have applied for a military pension based on a deceased family member's service. You may be able to access that information easier than other you can other resources.
