Otis Wheeler is a veteran of the Carthage fire department having served in that capacity 19 years. Then he became a law enforcement officer serving eight years as a deputy sheriff and about the same length of time as a member of the Carthage police force. He then served as police judge here from 1946 to 1950, at which time he retired.

Mr. Wheeler was married November 24, 1897 to Miss Anna Elizabeth Bynum at the home of her father, William R. Bynum, in Carthage. Their 58th wedding anniversary was last November.

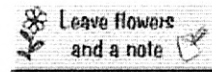

MRS. OTIS WHEELER DIES

END COMES SUDDENLY TO LONG TIME RESIDENT

Fatally Stricken on Way to Prepare Breakfast - Husband Celebrated 80th Birthday Yesterday

Mrs. Anna Elizabeth Wheeler, 77, wife of Otis L. Wheeler, former Carthage police judge and peace officer, died suddenly at 8 o'clock this morning in the family home., 517 W. Central. Mrs. Wheeler was ill last week, but appeared to be improving satisfactory. She came down stairs this morning and was on her way to the kitchen to prepare breakfast, when she became suddenly ill and sat down in a chair in the dining room. Mr. Wheeler, who was in the kitchen at the time summoned their son, Dr. A. B. Wheeler, Carthage osteopathic physician and surgeon, but Mrs. Wheeler passed away before her son arrived.

Came Here As Child

Mrs. Wheeler was born on October 4, 1878 in Staunton, Illinois. When she was a child her parents, Mr. and Mrs. William R. Bynum, moved to Carterville and the daughter Anna Elizabeth was graduated from High School there. Later the Bynum family came to Carthage and on November 24, 1897, the daughter was married to Otis D. Wheeler, at the Bynum home here. Yesterday - February 28 - was Mr. Wheeler's 80th birthday.

He retired in 1950 after a long career with the Carthage fire department and as a law enforcement officer.

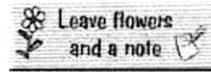

Ill the last six months, Dr. Wheeler underwent major surgery at Rochester, Minnesota, following examination and treatment at the Mayo Clinic. Two weeks ago his condition became more serious and he entered the Joplin Hospital.

He was a life-long resident of Carthage. Born August 13, 1898, he was graduated from High School here and from Kansas City College of Osteopathy. He also studied in Germany. Dr. Wheeler began a practice in Carthage in 1926 and continued in that profession until his health forced retirement. He was dean of Carthage Physicians. For 25 years, Dr. Wheeler was head of Stone Memorial Hospital, opened first at 1128 South Garrison [former John W Ground's 1897 built home, ~ followed by Dr Olga Chamberlin] and later moved to and greatly expanded 1069 South Garrison [former home of Martin A McNerney], now the Lucerne apartments. During his high school career here, Dr. Wheeler was an outstanding football player. Dr. Wheeler was active in civic work here, having served two years on the Carthage city council from the First ward, was a member of the Carthage Park Board several years and a member of the Chamber of Commerce. He was a member of the First Christian Church, Masonic Lodge No. 197 A.F. and A.M., the Carthage Shrine club and Fraternal Lodge No. 14, Knights of Pythias and a past grand chancellor of Missouri. Dr. Wheeler was a member of the Tri-State Osteopathic Association and a fellow in the American College of Osteopathic Surgeons, having served as vice president of the college in 1952. He was on the staff of Joplin General Hospital. He was a veteran of World War I

Surviving Dr. Wheeler are his wife, Mrs. Merle McCray Wheeler, to whom she was married June 15, 1941 in Carthage.

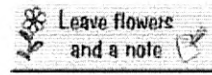

PHLL WHEELER DIES SUDDENLY IN VA HOSPITAL

Phyll T. Wheeler, 64, World War I veteran and former Carthage peace officer, died suddenly at 2:40 Tuesday in the Veteran's Hospital, Fayetteville, Arkansas

In ill health for some time, Mr. Wheeler was admitted to the hospital August 2 for treatment of a heart ailment. He appeared to be progressing satisfactorily prior to the sudden fatal attack.

The Wheeler home is at 1134 River Street. Born December 1899, in Carthage and, while attending Carthage high school was an outstanding football player.

During World War I, he served in France with the 5th Anti-aircraft battalion. He was discharged January 19, 1919, and a short time later went to Kansas City, where he was with Kansas City Public Service 12 years as a street car motorman and bus driver. Returning to Carthage in 1932, he began a 13 years career as peace officer. Mr. Wheeler served two years as constable, six on the police force as desk sergeant and five years as county jailer.

He was the last constable of Marion Township of which Carthage is a part. He stepped out of that job in December 1946 when the law abolished constables and justices of the peace and the magistrate system was inaugurated.

Wheeler resigned his post with the police department July 7, 1957 and was employed as a salesman for Sleepy's used car lot, serving there until his health forced him to retire.

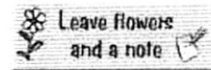

first settler on the prairie north of Avilla, having built his cabin and commenced opening up a farm in 1838.

The following article included in the book, and written by Walter Knight, gives the date a little earlier:

"Nelson Knight and Salena Elizabeth LaRue were married in Kentucky and came to Missouri soon after in 1836. Settled on what is known as the Old Campbell farm 3 1/2 miles N.E. of Avilla and made one crop there, then moved to the place 1/2 mile north of Knights Stations where they spent the rest of their lives.

Their second son, George, was born there and after his marriage, preempted forty acres south of his father's land, built a house and lived there until his death. He rode a horse to Springfield in one day, paid the U.S. Government \$1.25 per acre and returned the following day and night."

Copies of documents, census records, newspaper articles, and excerpts from local histories are used for interest and proof. Numerous charts and pictures of family members down to the present generation make this an attractive and valuable history of Nelson Knight and his descendants.

It is a tribute to the industry and persistence of the members of the family that they have cooperated to produce a history to be proud of.

Non-family members will enjoy reading the accounts of social events as they occurred in the early days of Missouri.
