Charles Duncan III, son of William and Ruth Raleigh Browning, was born October 8th, 1742 in Culpeper County, Virginia and died in March of 1789 in Muddy Creek, Madison County, Kentucky. Charles was a Revolutionary War Private in Virginia, Company 6, Captain Blackwell's Regiment. He was granted land warrant #1473 on August 1, 1783 for 100 acres for three years service as a soldier on the Virginia Continental Line. His estate sale was in September of 1803. Charles is buried in the Duncan graveyard in Madison County, Kentucky.
