

Shenandoah V.A. Marriage Bond

KNOW all men by these Presents, That *Wm William Molder and*
George Mutchison are held and firmly bound unto his Excellency *Robert Brooke*
Esq. Governor of Virginia, in the just and full sum of one hundred
and fifty Dollars, to which payment well and truly to be made, to
the said Governor, or his successors, we bind ourselves, our heirs, ex-
ecutors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these Pre-
sents. Sealed with our seal, and dated this *23^d* day of *October*
1795^m

THE condition of the above obligation is such, that, whereas there
is a marriage suddenly intended to be solemnized between the above
bound *William Molder* and *Ann Beaver*
now if there be no lawful cause to obstruct the said Marriage, then the
above obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain
in full force and virtue.
