THE JOHN HEARD OF KITTERY, MAINE FAMILY
This family daughtered out after only 4 generations.

001. JOHN HEARD 1, the son of _____

was born _____, and he died 1676 (per graveyard tablet).
He probably came to Kittery (now Maine) about 1634-35. He lived on
Champernoun's Island, then moved to the present day Eliot, Maine area,
before 1645.

He married, Isabel _____, who was born _____, and she
died _____ (she was living in 1676, when he wrote his will).

John made his will, dated 3 March 1675/76: sworn 21 February 1676/77:
recorded 16 March 1676/77.

(A single tablet marks these graves, inscribed:

"ERECTED TO THE MEMORY OF THE FOLLOWING EARLY SETTLERS WHOSE REMAINS ARE
HERE INTERRED", John Heard, died 1676; his wife Isabel Heard: their sons
Warwick Heard, died 1647; James Heard; Capt. John Heard son of James
1667-1751: his wife Phebe Littlefield Heard, who was killed by the
Indians 4 July 1697; their daughter Dorcas Heard Tucker, born 1690,
living 1762; Capt Nathan Bartlett 1691-1775; his wife Shuah Heard
Bartlett born 1694; four of their children, and a son Nathan Bartlett
1737-1775; Sarah Shapleigh Bartlett 1738-1805. A colored servant
Shuah Coffin born 1756, Apphia Coffin born 1759, and four other children
of Dr. Edmund Coffin who married Shuah Bartlett daughter of Capt. Nathan
Bartlett. A little north west, one hundred and twenty five yards from
this spot, stands the old Bartlett homestead built by Capt. Nathan
Bartlett about 1740, where five successive generations of the Bartlett
family have been born and reared). This Cemetery plot is called the
Bartlett Lot, on the south side of the Depot Road, in the field across
the road from the Nathan Bartlett Home.

issue. (2) at least (John and Isabel)

002. i. JAMES HEARD, born circa 1625-30, died _____ (after
6 July 1675, and before 3 March 1675/6.
He was deceased before his father wrote his will.
He married Shuah Conley, daughter of Abraham & Elizabeth
Conley. Some records show that he married Shuah Starbuck,
daughter of Edward Starbuck, however this is almost
certainly in error. Shuah was sometimes known as SUSANNA.

ii. WARWICK HEARD, born _____, died 23 March 1647
He was accidently killed by Charles Frost, while hunting
geese. Buried with his parents.

002. JAMES HEARD 2, JOHN 1, the son of John and Isabel (_____) Heard, was born circa 1625-30, and he died _____ (between 6 July 1675 and 3 March 1675/76. He was buried with his parents. He married (before 1661), Shuah Conley, who was born _____ the daughter of Abraham Conley. In her father-in-law's will she was shown as SUSANNA. Some records show that he married Shuah Starbuck, the daughter of Edward Starbuck, however this is almost certainly in error.

After James died, Shuah married Richard Otis (as his 2nd wife). (See VARNEY GENEALOGY, and the OTIS GENEALOGY (per Roger Easton 1985). Richard was from Dover, N.H. This marriage took place after 28 Nov. 1676, and before 5 Nov. 1677.

She married 1st, James Littlefield, who was born 2 Oct. 1657/58, Wells, Me. He may have been the son of Frances and Rubella (Rusk) Littlefield ?????? Possibly he died 17 May 1690 ??????

She married 2nd, John Wooden of Wells, Me.

v. ABIGAIL HEARD, born _____ (under 18 in 1675/76)
 married (2 Feb. 1688/89), Job Clements

vi. ANN HEARD, born _____ (under 18 in 1675/76)
 married Moses Gilman.

003. JOHN HEARD 3, JAMES 2, JOHN 1, the son of James and Shuah (Conley)

Heard, was born 1667, and he died November 1751.
He wrote his will 30 January 1739, and it was probated 2 January 1752.
He died on his grandfather's farm at Sturgeon Creek.

He married 1st (27 April 1690), Phebe Littlefield, the daughter of Francis and Rebecca (Rust) Littlefield. (also shown as Rubella Rusk)???. She was born 1668 in Wells, Me., and she was killed by the Indians at "Ambush Rock" on 4 July 1697 (possibly 1696) ?? Both buried on his grandfather's lot, Eliot, Me.

He married 2nd (2 July 1698), Mrs Jane (Cole) Littlefield, the widow of Joseph Littlefield. She was born circa 1660, the daughter of Nicholas and Relief Cole. Jane had children by her 1st marriage, JOSEPH, MERIBAH, AND PRISCILLA LITTLEFIELD.

He married 3rd (Dec. 1725), Mrs Ann Wingate, the widow of Capt. John Wingate. No record of issue by this marriage.

He married 4th (23 Dec. 1735), Mrs Maria (Cotton) Bradbury of York, Me.

married (21 Nov. 1717), Hugh Tucker
- ii. PHEBE HEARD, born 15 (or 25) January 1692/93
married 1st, Abraham Morrill
married 2nd (1724), Thomas Stevens of Newcastle, N.H.
- iii. SHUAH HEARD, born 25 January 1694/95
She married (10 March 1714), Capt. Nathan Bartlett of Newbury, who was born 1691, and died 1775.
They had 12 children (per Scales History),
4 of whom were (not in order)
 - a. NATHAN BARTLETT, born 1737, died 1775
 - b. SARAH SHAPLEIGH BARTLETT, born 1738, died 1805
 - c. SHUAH BARTLETT, married Dr. Edmund Coffin
 - d. JOHN HEARD BARTLETT (per Shuah's father's will)
- iv. JAMES HEARD, born 21 January 1696/7
died _____ (probably before 3 Oct. 1725).

The Kittery V.R. Film shows that a JAMES HERD was Bap't.
6 June 1708 (may or may not be the same person)???

He married (7 April 1720, Dover, N.H.V.R.),
Mary Roberts of Dover, New Hampshire, the daughter of Hatevil
and Lydia Roberts. She was born 20 April 1700/01, and she
died 3 July 1759.

Mary probably married 2nd (1 May 1726),
Samuel Wingate of Dover, New Hampshire.

Mary probably married 3rd,
Deacon John Hayes (as his 3rd wife).

(all information is per Roger Easton)

- a. SARAH HEARD, bpt. 17 June 1722
married (21 July 1742), Benjamin Chadbourne
- b. MARY HEARD, bpt. 17 June 1722, died before 1739
- c. PHEBE HEARD, born 15 Dec. 1723, bpt. 26 April 1724
married Abraham Lord
- d. JANE HEARD, bpt. 3 Oct. 1725, died before 1739

issue. (3) (by his 2nd marriage, John and Jane) (all born Kittery)

- v. JANE HEARD, born 18 June 1699, died before 1739
She married (15 Nov. 1719), Capt. Tristram Coffin of Dover,
New Hampshire, the son of Tristram and Deborah (Colcord)
Coffin. (apparently they had issue, see Scales History).

After Jane died, Tristram married 2nd to _____
By this 2nd marriage he had issue, at least a daughter,
DEBBY COFFIN (per Scales History, page 446).

- vi. MARY HEARD, born 24 August 1700
She married (1 July 1722), Henry Barter (or Baxter, per Scales
History), probably BARTER is correct ???
- vii. ABIGAIL HEARD, born 15 April 1702, died 1768
She married (26 Dec. 1723), Moses Hubbard, who was born 8 July
1700, Kittery, Me., and he died there 1784, the son of Capt.
Phillip Hubbard (born Isle of Jersey, England) and
Mrs Elizabeth (Goodwin) Emery.
