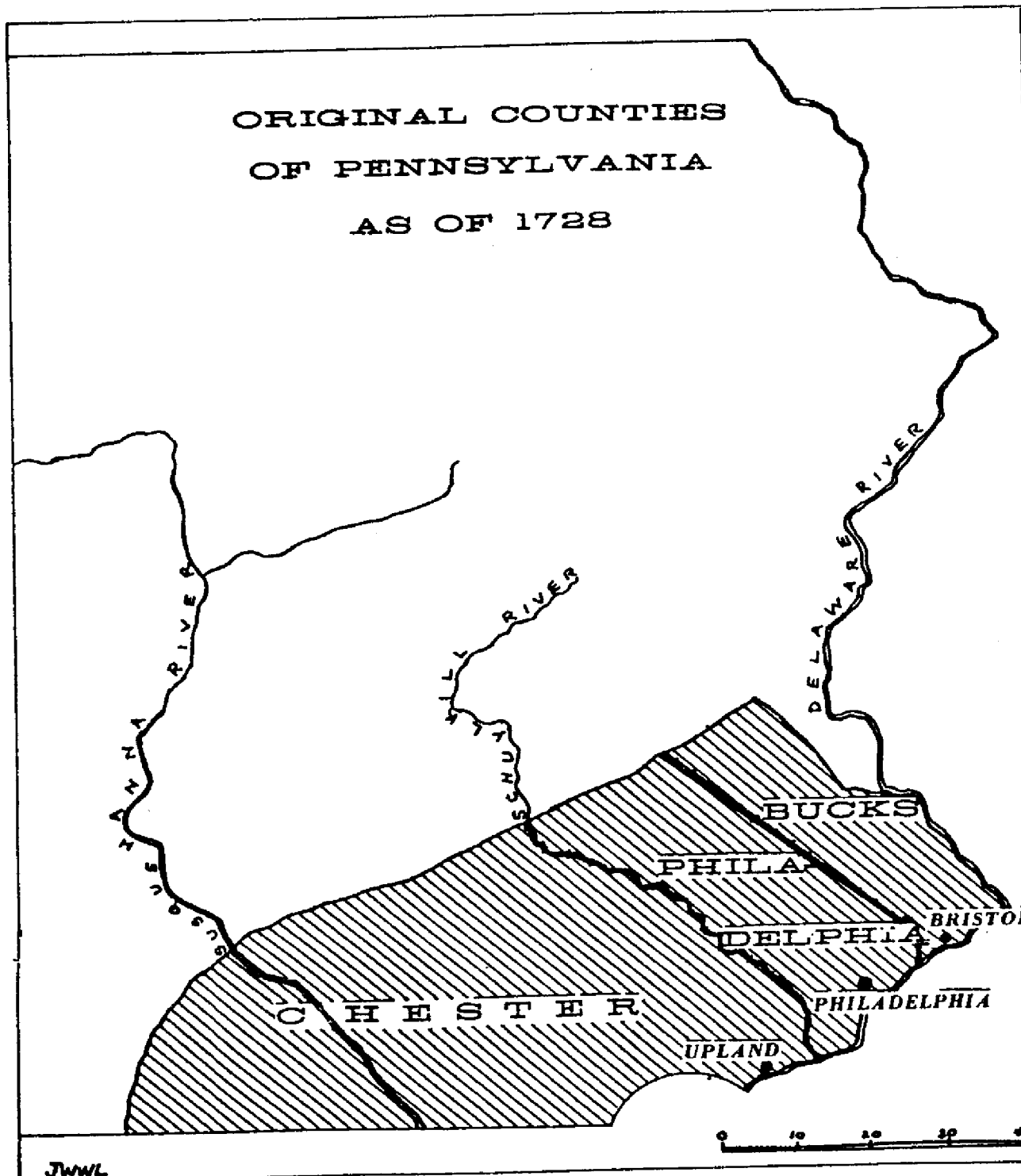
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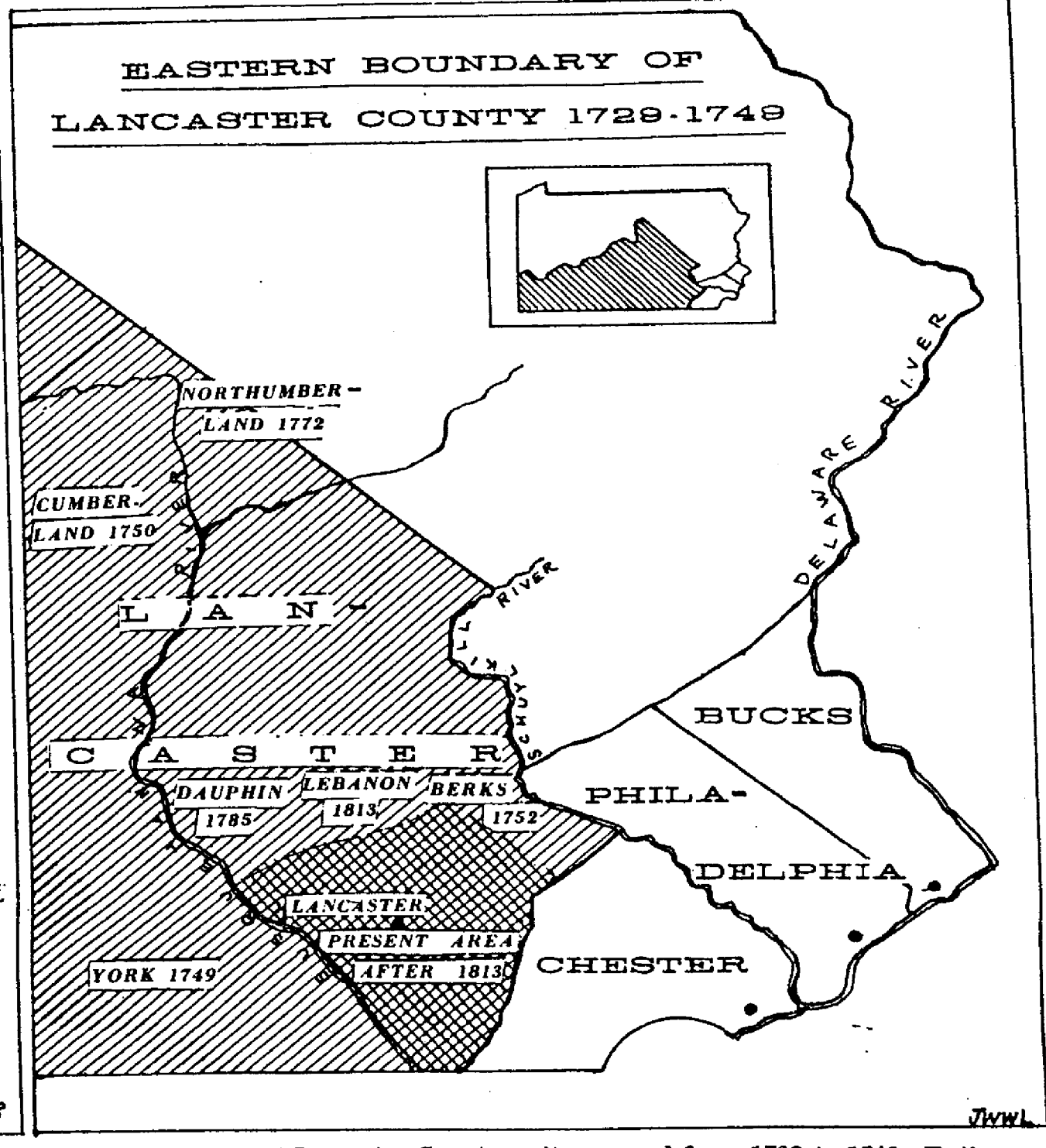
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Original counties of Pennsylvania just before erection of Lancaster County in 1729.



Eastern portion of Lancaster County as it appeared from 1729 to 1749. Entire extent of Lancaster County during that period is shown in insert map.

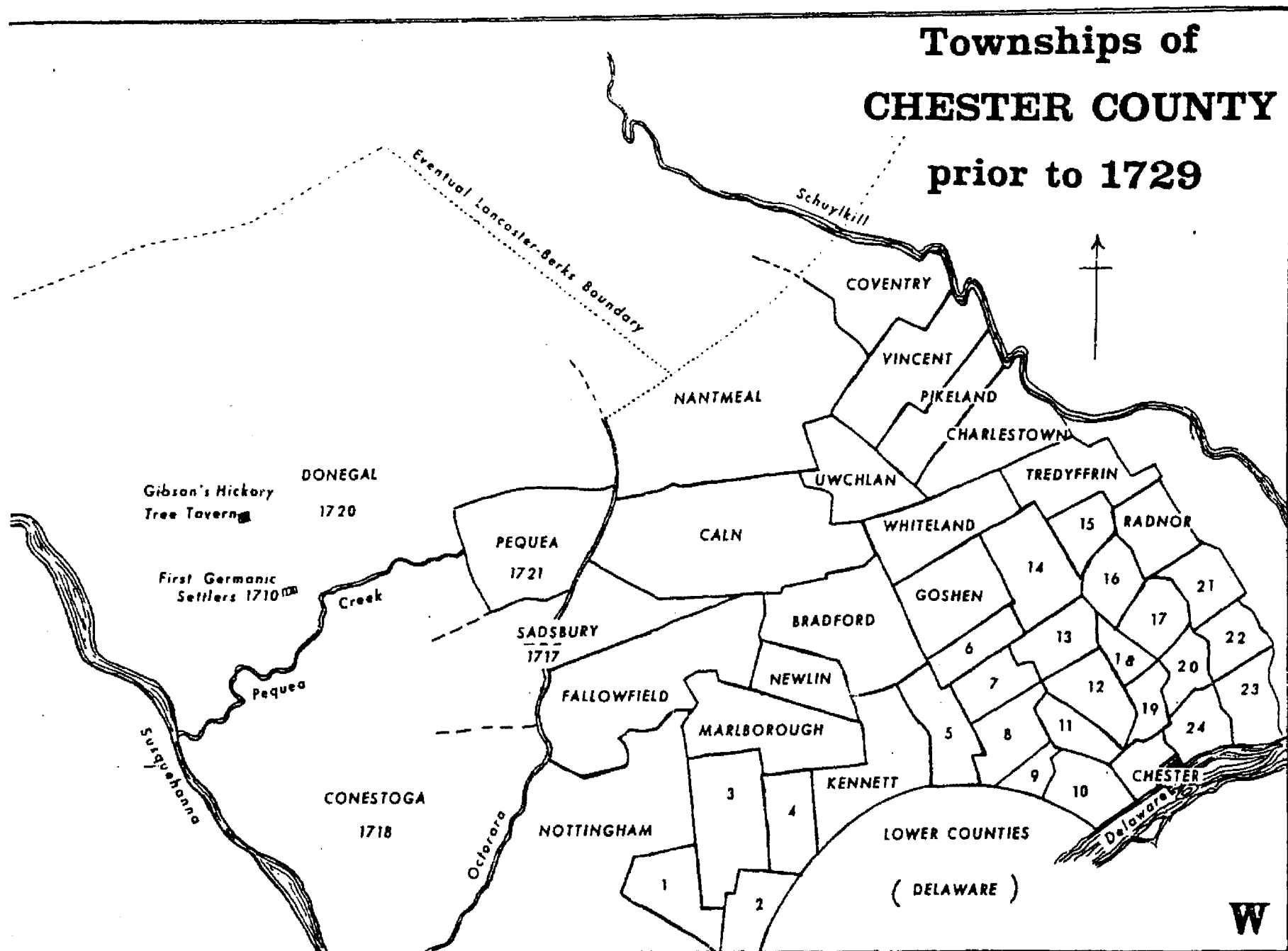

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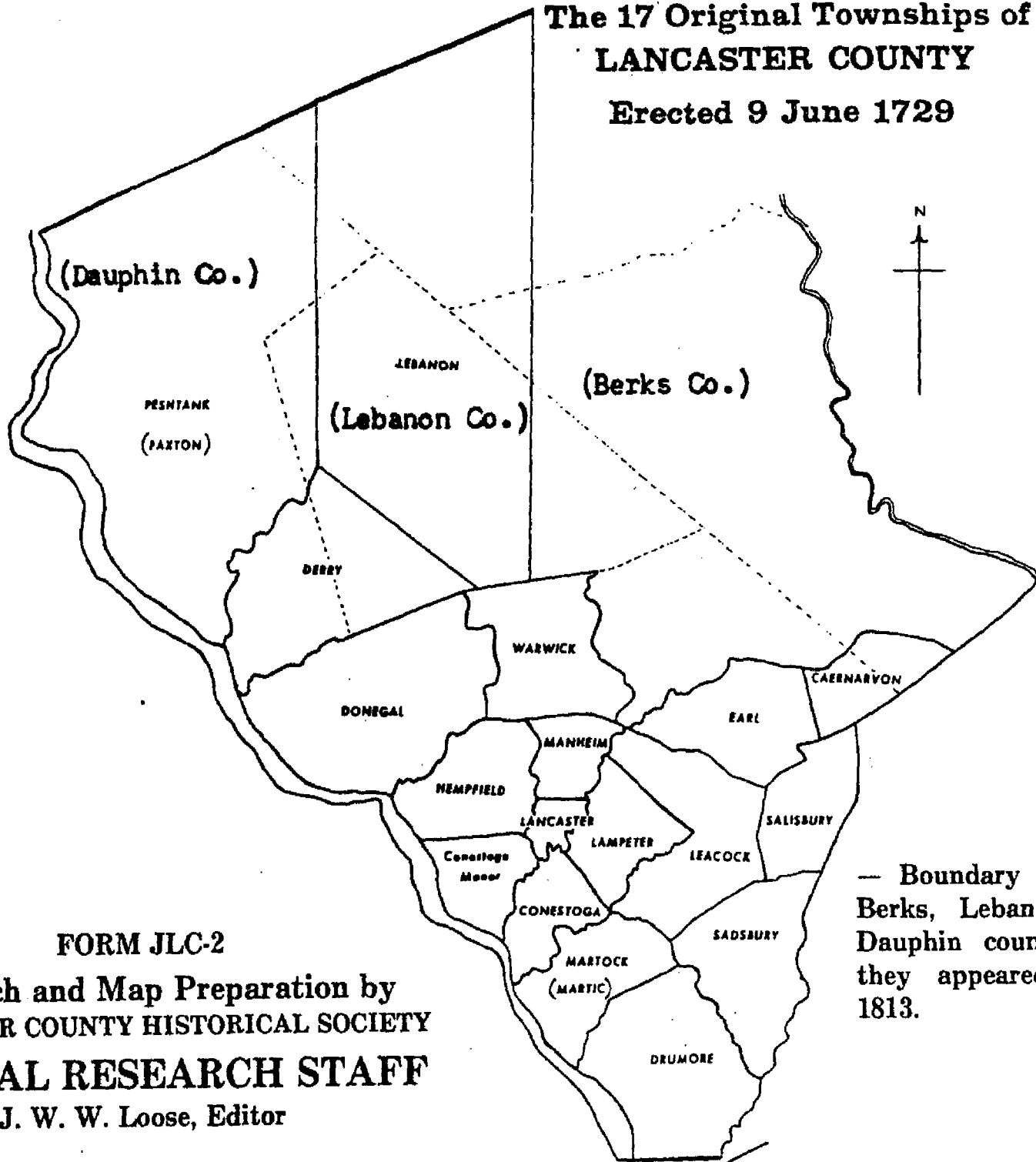

PETITION TO ERECT A NEW COUNTY OUT OF UPPER CHESTER COUNTY

At a Council held at Philadelphia, February 6th, 1729,

A petition of the inhabitants of the upper parts of Chester County was laid before the Board and read, setting forth, that by reason of their great distance from the county town, where Courts are held, offices are kept, and annual elections made, they lie under very great inconveniences, being obliged in the recovery of their just debts, to travel near one hundred miles to obtain a writ; that for want of a sufficient number of Justices, Constables and other officers, in those parts, no care is taken of the high-ways; Townships are not laid out, nor bridges built, when there is an apparent necessity for them; and further that for want of a Gaol there, several vagabonds and other dissolute people harbour among them, thinking themselves safe from justice in so remote a place; and therefore praying that a Division Line be made between the upper and lower part of said county, and the upper part thereof erected into a county, with all the immunities, rights and privileges which any other county of this Province does now enjoy.

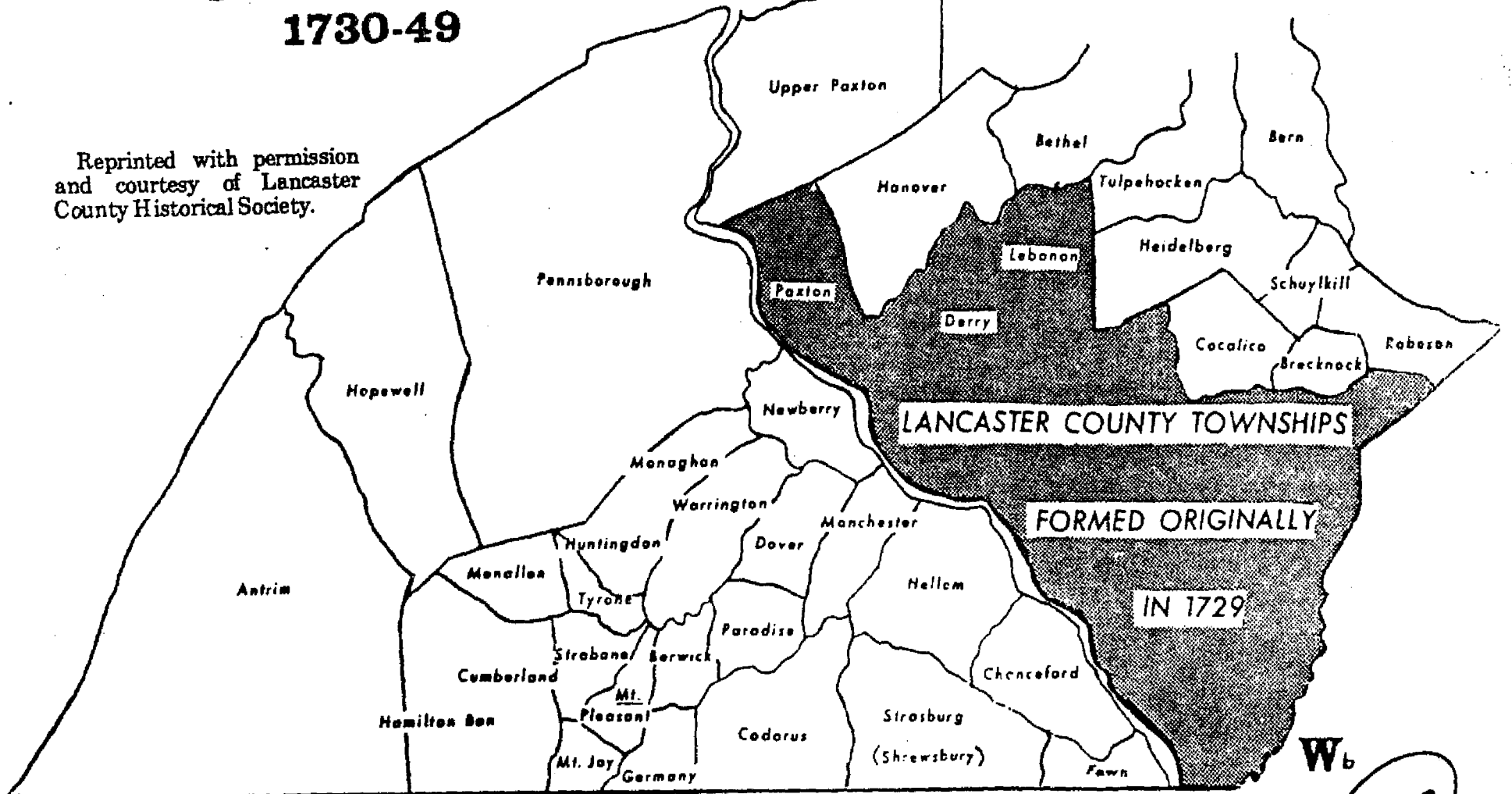


— Boundary lines of Berks, Lebanon and Dauphin counties as they appeared after 1813.

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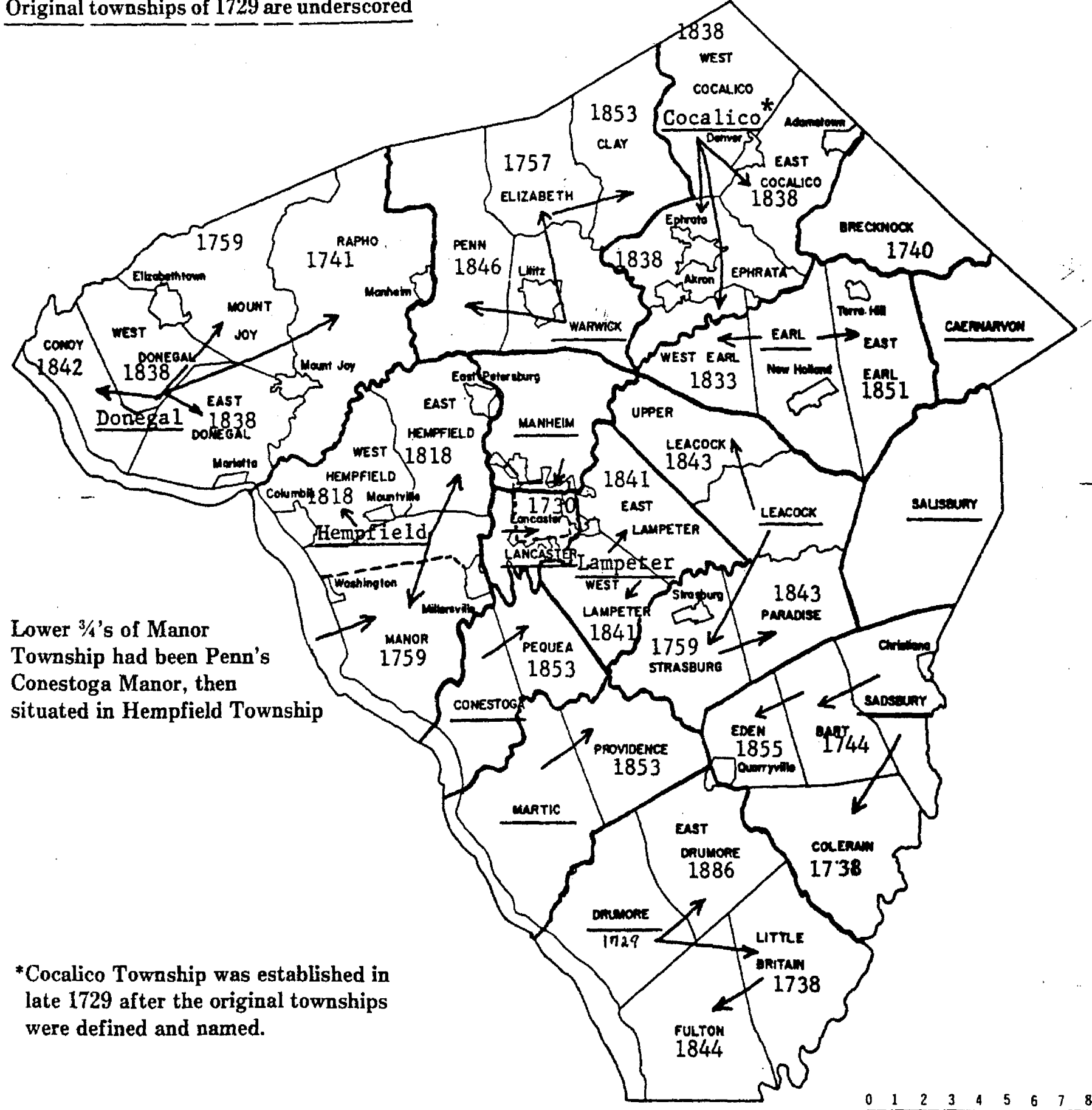
