Two colored children, daus. of Clara emancipated by John Carter, to be emancipated. Sarah, my beloved wife; sons Elisha Carter and Ellis Carter; three daughters: Polly Keller; Sophia Logue; Jemima Williams; son-in-law Henry Keller; son-in-law Thomas Williams.

Also appointed Elisha Carter, James Weems; Ellis Carter and George Weems execs.

Page 107

ABRAHAM CARTER, dec'd. Proven 26 Oct. 1832

Will proven by John Logue and Henry Simpson. Rebecca, my beloved wife. Sell property and divide equally between Nancy Weems, Temperance Malone; Elenor Keller; Elizabeth King; Sarah Edmonds, and Rebecca, my wife. I also will to Ezekiel Carter and John Carter; Enoch Carter; and Mashac Carter my sons: \$1.00 each.

Dated 22 March 1832.

Ezekiel Carter and John Carter to be my execs.

Ezekiel Carter posted \$1,000 bond - Jacob Carter his security.

JOHN CARTER decd. 22 July, 1833. Will proven by Benjamin Carter and Abel Carter, witnesses: wife Cristenen Carter - if she marries or dies, estate to be divided equally among my living children (not named).

Page 149

JAMES CARTER, decd. 3 Oct. 1836, Proved by Adin Humbred and Samuel Humbred,

Witnesses, I. James Carter, Sr. --- Wife Rebecca; youngest son Abel Carter; heirs of Abner Carter, my son that died in state of Indiana (heirs not named); heirs of John Carter that died in state of Indiana; to Rebecca Gass, the dau. of William Brown and Catherine Carter; to William Carter living in the state of Indiana; dau.
