She married #2 Abraham Monroe "Arba"
Rounsavall on Aug 18, 1967 in Henderson Co.,
Texas. They were the parents of two children:
an infant (dates unknown- probably stillborn)
buried in this cemetery and James Monroe
Rounsavall 1871-1952 also buried in this
cemetery.

Several documents show her listed as either "Fannie" or "Emily". She is the sister of Hugh Carter b. 1833 TN also buried in this cemetery.




