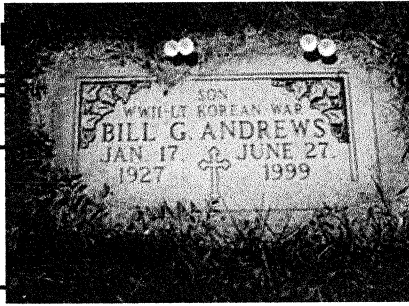

Obituaries

Las Vegas businesswoman Wilma A. Panos, passed away June 2, 2004, in Tucson, Ariz. Wilma was the third child of Gus and Jenny Andrews, born Feb. 15, 1922, into a family of 7. The family later moved to Magna, Utah, in 1924, where she attended elementary school, and when the family moved to McGill, in 1934, she attended and graduated from White Pine County High school. Wilma then worked for White Pine County Recorder, and also for Wilson Bates Furniture Company as a bookkeeper. On Feb. 15, 1942, she married Tom S. Panos in a civil ceremony in Ely, and then had the marriage solemnized in the first Greek Orthodox wedding to be held in Las Vegas that same year. Tom and Wilma as they were known, owned several restaurants in Las Vegas: the Chili King and later, in 1951, they opened the Melodie Lane Restaurant on the corner of 3rd and Fremont that would become a 20-year landmark. They later invested in the Panos Manor Apartments, a portion of the University Shopping Center, and other properties throughout the city. Tom and Wilma were true partners not only in marriage, but also in all their business ventures until his death in 1999. Wilma has remained active in the St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church's ministries over the years with the

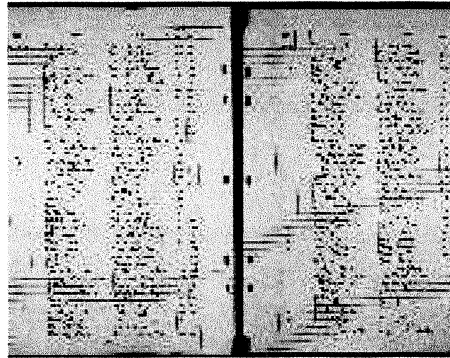

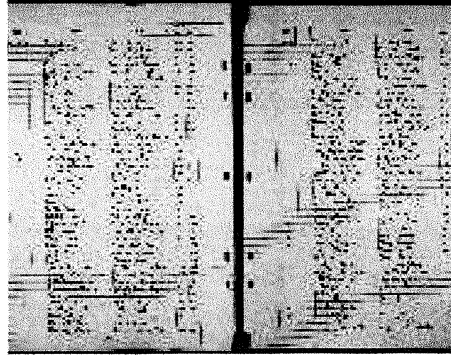

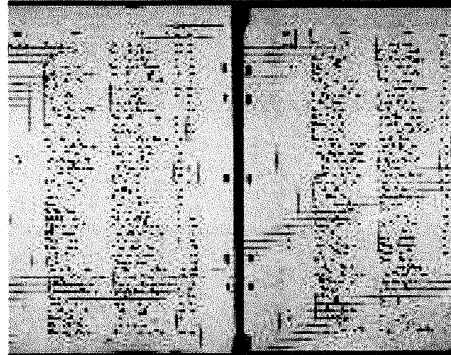

LAS VEGAS — A funeral for Stan "Butch" Malaperdas, 50, who died Wednesday of cancer at Nathan Adelson Hospice in Las Vegas, was held Monday at Wilson-Bates Mortuary, Ely.

A native of Long Beach, Calif., he was born May 7, 1940, and had lived in Las Vegas since 1984, coming from Ely.

Malaperdas had worked for Kennecott Copper Corp. in McGill for 20 years as a purchasing agent and was employed by Reynolds Electrical Engineering Company in Las Vegas, was a past president of the Order of AHEPA, and during the late 1950s, he was a member of group "The Hounddogs," and played drums with the group "The Undertakers," during the 1960s. He attended White Pine County schools and graduated from high school in 1958.
