 have ^{been} published three for all Lord's Days in the parish Church
 of Langham aforesaid all the Close of the morning except prayer
 to the Tenor of the late act of Parliament in full case made and
 provided the first Day of publication was the Sabbath and Monday
 Day of August in the year of our Lord god one Thousand Six
 hundred fiftie and four the second was the third Day of Septem
 ber ensuing and the last was the tenth Day of the same month
 and Marriage was had and Solemnized betwene the saids
 the Tenth Day of October at Barkby in the County of Linstor
 before Thomas Pulten Esquire one of the Justices of the peace
 of that same County: 1644.
